Appendix 'A'

Regulation 294 :-

- a) Candidate who secures 50% or more but less than 60% marks in the aggregate and passes the examinations by taking Part – I and Part – II examinations separately as a regular student or by taking Part – I and Part – II examination together as a regular student or as an ex-student, will be declared to have passed the examination in Second Divison.
 - b) Candidate who secure 60% or more but less than 66% marks in the aggregate and passes the examination by taking Part – I and Part –II examinations separately as a regular student or taking Part – I and Part –II examinations together as a regular student or as an ex-students, will be declared to have passed the examination in the First Divison.
 - c) Candidate who secure 66% or more marks in the aggregate and pass the examination by taking Part – I and Part –II examinations separately as a regular student or taking Part – I and Part –II examinations B.E. (Civil-Water-Management) Examination together as a regular student or as an ex-student, will be declared to have passed the examination in First Divison with Distinction.
